Queen of Hearts Hat

Tools And Materials

Yarn used	Artesano 4ply
Colour & Shade No.	A: Violet B: Biscuit C: Forget-me-not D: Anemone
Amount used	A: 1 x 50g B: 1 x 50g C: 1 x 50g D: 1 x 50g
Tension	28sts. and 32 rows to 4" (10cm) square on 3.25mm needles over stocking stitch.
Needles used	1 pair Brittany needles size 2.75mm 1 pair Brittany 3.25mm needles
Other supplies	None
Sizing	S M L

Instructions

Using 3.25mm needles and A, cast on 85(101, 117) sts.
Work 6 rows in st. st.
Working from Graph 1 in B, cont. as follows:

k3(5, 7)sts. A, 7sts. 1st row Graph in B, k2
Repeat from * to * to last 1(3, 5) sts. k to end.
Cont. until row 7 of heart graph has been completed.
Beg. with p row, work 3 (5, 5) rows in A and st. st.
Change to C and work 2(4, 4) rows in st. st.
Change to B and work 2(2, 4) rows in st. st.
Change to C and work 2(4, 4) rows in st. st.
Change to D and work 4(6, 6) rows in st. st.
Working from Graph 2 continue as follows:

k3(5, 7) sts. D, 7 sts. 1st row graph in A, k2.
Repeat from * to * to last 1(3, 5) sts., k to end.
Cont. until row 7 of diamond graph has been completed
In D, work further 3(5, 5) rows in st. st.
Repeat stripe sequence in C, B, and C.

Shape Crown

In A ktog. every 7th and 8th sts. to end of row.
Next and every following alt. row: p
Ktog. every 6th and 7th sts. to end of row.
Ktog. every 5th and 6th sts. to end of row.
Ktog. every 4th and 5th sts. to end of row.
Ktog. every 3rd and 4th sts. to end of row.
Ktog. every 2nd and 3rd sts. to end of row.
K2tog. across all sts.
Break A, leaving long tail
Join in B and p 1 row.

Next row: k into front and back of every st.

Repeat last row twice more.

Cast off as follows:

*k2tog. place worked st. back onto left needle, repeat from * to end. Fasten off securely.

Finishing

Using 2.75mm needles, pick up 85(101, 117) sts. from cast on sts at bottom edge.

K into front and back of every st. for 2 rows.

Cast off as before. Join centre back seam matching stripes.

Artesano

Queen of Hearts Mittens

Tools And Materials

Yarn used	Artesano 4ply
Colour & Shade No.	A: Violet B: Biscuit
Amount used	A: 1 x 50g B: 1 x 50g
Tension	28sts and 40 rows to 4" (10cms) square on 2.75mm needles over stocking stitch.
Needles used	1 set Brittany 2.75mm dpns
Other supplies	Stitch holder
Sizing	S M L

Right Mitten

Using 2.75mm dpns needles and Colour A, cast on 34(38, 42)sts. Arrange evenly over 3 pins. Place marker.

1st row: k to end of round.

Repeat last row until work measures 1 ¾ (2, 2 ½)" 4(5, 6)cms from beg.*

Thumb Gusset

1st round: k2, m1, k1, m1, k to end of round.

2nd and every alternate round: k

3rd round: k1, m1, k3, m1, k to end of round.

Continue as set increasing 1 st before and after m1 from last inc. round until 4(5, 6) inc. rounds have been worked 42(48, 52)sts. Work 2 rounds without shaping.

Next round: k2, place next 9(11, 13)sts on st. holder. Cast on 1 st. at base of thumb and k to end. 34(38, 42)sts.

Continue in rounds until work measures 1(1 ½, 2)" 2(4, 5)cms from thumb hole finishing at marker. +

Divide For Fingerless Welt

K16(18, 20)sts., then place remaining 18(20, 22)sts on st. holder.

Cast on 16(18, 20) sts. Divide evenly over 3 pins.

Next round: k1, p1 to end of round. Continue until rib measures 1(1, 1 ½)" 2(2, 4)cms.

Cast off in rib.

Mitten Hood

Place 18(20, 22)sts from st. holder onto dpns and work round as follows:

K to end, Cast on 16(18, 20) sts. 34(38, 42)sts. Arrange on three pins. Place marker and resume knitting in the round as follows: k19(20, 19)sts,(k1, p1) to end of round. Repeat last round 7(9, 11) times more. Knitting every round, work 8(10, 12) rounds finishing at marker.

Shape Mitten Hood

1st round: (k1, k2tog.tbl, k11(13, 15), k2tog k1) twice

2nd round: k

3rd round: (k1, k2togtbl, k9(11, 13) k2tog, k1) twice

4th round: (k1, k2togtbl, k7(9, 11) k2tog, k1) twice

Continue dec. on every round until 10sts. remain.

Arrange sts. on two pins and graft together the two sets of 5sts. as follows:

Break yarn and thread crewel needle

*Place needle through 1st st on front pin as if to knit and remove from pin, place needle through 2nd st on front pin as if to purl and leave on pin.

Place needle through 1st st on back pin as if to purl and remove from pin. Place needle through 2nd st on back pin as if to knit and leave on pin.Repeat from * to end. Fasten off securely.

Thumb

Using pair 2.75mm needles, knit across 9(11, 13)sts. on st. holder.Cast on 3sts, purl to end. Work a further 10(12, 16) rows in st.st.

Next row: k2tog across all sts 5(6, 8)sts.

Next row: k1(0, 0,) k2tog to end. Break yarn and thread through remaining 3(3, 4)sts.

Fasten off securely and stitch thumb seam. Sew 3cast on sts. to mitten at base of thumb.

Left Mitten

Work as for right mitten to *

Thumb Gusset

K to last 3sts before marker, m1, k1, m1, k2.

Continue as for right mitten to +

Divide for fingerless welt

K18(20,22)sts and place on st. holder. Cast on 16(18, 20)sts.

Divide evenly over three pins. (k1, p1) to end and complete to match right mitten.

Work Mitten flap as for right mitten

Finishing

Sew in all ends.

Stitch cast on sts at base of fingerless welt to base of mitten flaps. Crochet button loop to top of mitten flaps.

Make buttons

Using 2 strands of yarn B and crochet hook, work 6 chain, and join to 1st chain to form circle. Work dc round chain and through centre hole until centre hole is filled up. Fasten off securely.

Edging

Using 2.75mm dpns, pick up 34(38, 42)sts.

K into front and back of every st. Repeat last round once more.

Cast off as follows:

^ K2tog, place worked st. back onto left needle. Repeat from

^ until casting off is completed. Fasten off securely.

Queen of Hearts Cardigan

Tools And Materials

Yarn used	Artesano 4ply
Colour & Shade No.	A: Violet B: Biscuit C: Forget-me-not D: Anemone
Amount used	A: 1(1, 2, 2, 2) x 50g B: 1(1, 2, 2, 2) x 50g C: 1(1, 2, 2, 2) x 50g D: 1(1, 2, 2, 2) x 50g
Tension	28sts and 32 rows to 4" (10cms) square on 3.25mm needles over stocking stitch
Needles used	1 pair Brittany 3.25mm needles 1 X 2.75mm circular needle
Other supplies	2 Buttons
Sizing	To fit: 18(20, 22, 24, 26)", 46(51, 56, 61, 66) cms chest Actual measurements: 20(22, 25, 27, 29)" 51(56, 64, 69, 74)cms Sleeve length: 7(8, 8 ¾, 9 ¼, 10)" 18(20, 22, 24, 26)cms Length: 13(14, 15, 16, 17)" 33(36, 38, 41, 44)cms.

Back

Using 3.25mm needles and A, cast on 85(93, 101, 109, 117)sts.

Work 4 rows in st.st.

Working from Graph 1 in B continue as follows:

k3(4, 5, 6, 7)sts. A, 7sts Graph 1st row B, k2. Repeat from * to * to last 1(2, 3, 4, 5)sts., k to end.

Cont. until 7th row of graph has been worked. P1 row A

Shape Sides

In A, k2tog at each end of next and every following 6th(6th, 8th, 8th, 10th) row to 71(79, 87, 95, 103)sts. p1 row.

AT THE SAME TIME work in pattern as follows:

In C work 2(2, 4, 4, 4) rows in st. st.

In B work 2(2, 2, 4, 4) rows in st. st.

In C work 2(2, 4, 4, 4) rows in st. st.

In D work 4 rows in st. st.

Working from Graph 2 in A, continue as follows:

K2tog (k2tog, k2tog, -, -)in D, k0(0, 1, 3, 5) sts. in D*, 7sts

Graph 1st row A, k5(6, 7, 8, 9)sts in D.

Repeat from * to last 8(9, 10, 10, 12)sts, work Diamond, k2tog(k2tog, k1k2tog, k3, k5). Work 3 rows in D in st.st.

Cont. in stripes and pattern, placing Hearts and Diamonds in

panel has been line until 2nd Heart completed. Change to C and work 2(2, 4, 4, 4) rows in st. st.

Change to B – RS facing – Eyelet row:

In B: (k3, yfwd, k2tog twice, yfwd) to last 1(3, 3, 4, 5)sts., k1(k3, k3, yfwd k2tog k2, yfwd k2tog k3).

Resume working in stripes and pattern as before until work measures 7 ½, (8, 9, 10, 11)" 19(20, 23, 26, 28)cms.

Shape Armholes

Dec 1 st. at each end of next 3 rows 65(73, 81, 89, 97)sts.

Then on every alt. row to 55(61, 67, 73, 79)sts.

Cont. straight until work measures 4(4 ½, 5, 5 ½, 6)"

10(11, 13, 14, 15)cms from start of armhole shaping.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 14(15, 16, 17, 18)sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off remaining 27(31, 35, 39, 43)sts for back neck.

Left Front

Using 3.25mm needles and A, cast on 25(30, 35, 37, 41)sts.

K 1 row.

Shape front edge – WS facing

1st row: cast on 3 sts. purl to end.

2nd row: k

3rd row: cast on 3 sts. p to end.

4th row: *k3(4, 5, 6, 7) sts in A, work row 1 of graph 1 in B, k2. Repeat from * to last 7(10, 13, 13, 15) sts., k6(7, 8, 9, 10) sts. A, k1B, k0(2, 4, 3, 4) sts. A.

Cont in pattern as set, taking extra sts. into pattern – cast on 3sts. at beg. of next and following 2 alt. rows.

40(45, 50, 52, 56) sts.

Shape Side Edge

(RS facing)

Keeping front edge straight, dec. 1 st. at beg. of 3rd and every following 6th(6th, 8th, 8th, 10th) row to 33(38, 43, 45, 49)sts.

Work straight in pattern until work measures same as back to eyelet row.

RS facing:

(k3, yfwd, k2togtwice, yfwd) to last 5(3, 1, 3, 7) sts.,

k3yfwdk2tog(k3, k1, k3, k3yfwd.k2tog.k2)

Work straight to same length as Back to armhole shaping.

Shape Armhole And Front Edge

1st row: k2tog., k to last 2 sts., k2tog.

2nd row: p to last 2 sts. k2tog.

3rd row: as 1st row.

4th row: p 28(33, 38, 40, 44)sts.

Dec1 st. at each end of next and following alt. rows to 14(15, 16, 17, 18) sts.

Cont. straight until armhole measures same as back to shoulder. Castoff.

Right Front

Using 3.25mm needles, and A, cast on 25(30, 35, 37, 41) sts.

1st row: k

2nd row: p

3rd row: cast on 3 sts. k to end.

4th row: p

5th row: cast on 3 sts., k0(2, 4, 3, 4) sts. A, * k1B,

k11(12, 13, 14, 15)sts A.

Repeat from * to last 7(8, 9, 10, 11) sts., k1B, k to end of row.

6th row: *p3(4, 5, 6, 7) sts. A, work 2nd row Graph 1 in B, p2A. Repeat from * to last 7(10, 13, 13, 15) sts., p5(6, 7, 8, 9) sts A, p2(3, 3, 3, 3)B, p-(1, 3, 2, 3)A.

Cast on 3 sts. at beg. of next and following 2 alt. rows at front

edge, following Graph 1 as set 40(45, 50, 52, 56)sts.
P1 rowA.

Cont. as for left front, dec 1 st. at end of next and every following 6th(6th, 8th, 8th, 10th) row to 33(38, 43, 45, 49) sts. Placing stripes, Hearts and Diamonds, as before, work to match left front, reversing all shapings. Cast off.

Sleeves (Both Alike)

Using 3.25mm needles and A, cast on 39(43, 51, 53, 55) sts. Beg. with k row, work 2 rows st. st.

Shape Wrist

Dec 1 st. at each end of next and following alt row to 31(35, 41, 43, 45) sts.

AT THE SAME TIME

commence pattern on 3rd row as follows:

K2tog., k1(2, 5, 5, 5)A, * 1st row Graph 1 B, k5(6, 7, 8, 9) sts. A, repeat from * to last 10(11, 14, 14, 14) sts., Graph 7 sts., k1(2, 5, 5, 5) sts A, k2tog. Cont. until 7 graph rows have been worked. Work 3 rows A in st. st.

Side Shaping

Inc. 1 st. at each end of next and every following 6th row to 47(51, 57, 63, 67) sts. working pattern and stripes as set and as on Back, until sleeve measures 7 1/2, (8, 8 3/4, 9 1/4, 10)", 19(20, 22, 24, 25)cms.

Shape Sleeve Top

Keeping pattern as set, dec 1 st. at each end of next 3 rows. 41(45, 51, 57, 61) sts.

Dec. 1 st. at each end of next and every following alt. row to 25(25, 29, 35, 39) sts.

P 1 row.

Dec. 1 st. at each end of every row to 9(11, 13, 15, 17) sts.

p0(1, 0, 0, 1) row.

Cast off.

Finishing

Sew in all ends. Press lightly. Using fine backstitch, join shoulder and side seams.

Edging

Make 2 buttonholes on right front when picking up sts. for edging by leaving 1/2 " space just above and below eyelet row

Using 2.75mm circular

needle, RS facing, and starting at bottom right seam, pick up 23(28, 33, 35, 39) sts. from bottom right front, 18 sts. from front shaping, 46(46, 54, 62, 62) sts. from straight front edge, 33(37, 41, 45, 49) sts. from right front neck shaping to shoulder, 26(30, 34, 38, 42) sts from back neck, 33(37, 41, 45, 49) sts. from left front neck, 46(46, 54, 62, 62) sts. from left front edge, 18 sts. from left front shaping, 23(28, 33, 35, 39) sts from bottom of left front, 80(88, 96, 104, 112) sts. from bottom of back. 346(376, 422, 462, 490) sts.

Work in rounds, k into front and back of every st. for 2 rounds.

Cast off as follows:

*k2tog., place worked st. back onto left needle. Repeat from * to end. Fasten off.

Sleeve Edges

Using 2.75mm needles RS facing, pick up 36(40, 48, 50, 52) sts. from cast on sts.

Next 2 rows: k into front and back of every st. Cast off as for body edging.

Join sleeve seams and set sleeves into armholes.

Tie Cord

Using 2 2.75mm dpns, cast on 3 sts. and k.

Without turning work, slide sts back along needle, bringing yarn tightly behind. Repeat until cord is long enough to thread through eyelet holes and tie in a bow.. Cast off.

Sew on buttons to left front edge to correspond with buttonholes.


