

snuggle cable snood

Designed by Monica Russel

This snood is a fantastic item for your wardrobe on a wintry day when you want to feel snuggled up in something warm and look stylish. I have chosen to knit it in a neutral colour that will match most items in your wardrobe but just pick your favourite colour and away you go. It is knitted with large needles and yarn double so is a great quick knit. This snood compliments the fair isle knits and cable hat.

Yarn

7 x 50g balls (94m/103yds) Rooster Almerino Aran
(50% baby alpaca/50% merino wool)
Colour: 315 Shimmer

Needles

1 pair of 9mm (UK 00 / US 13) single pointed needles
1 tapestry needle
1 large cable needle

Size

Length: 70in (178cm) before sewing up
Width: 10.5in (27cm)

Tension

Tension using 9mm needles: 20sts x 24 rows = 4in(10cms)

Note

Yarn is used double throughout pattern



Abbreviations

C8B place 4 sts on cable holder and hold at back of work, K4, K4 from cable holder

C8F place 4 sts on cable holder and hold at front of work, K4, K4 from cable holder

ktbl through the back of the stitch to form a neat cast on edge (this only needs to be done for a traditional cast on)

K knit

P purl

cms centimeters

sts stitches

Knitting the Snood

Note yarn is used double throughout the pattern

Using 9mm needles cast on 36sts

Next Row: ktbl–

Garter and Stockinette Stitch Cable

Rows 1, 3, 5, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 21, 23: K7, P3, K16, P3, K7

Rows 2, 4, 6, 20, 22 and 24 : K2, P5, K3,* P4, K4 rep from * once more, K3, P5, K2

Row 7: K7, P3, * C8B, rep from * once more, P3, K7

Rows 8, 10, 12, 14, 16 and 18: K2, P5, K3, * K4, P4, rep from * once more, K3, P5, K2

Row 19: :K7, P3, * C8B, rep from * once more, P3, K7

Repeat these 24 rows eight more times and then rows 1–20 once more. Work will measure approximately 178cm.

Cast off stitches.

To make up

Weave in all loose ends to the rear of work.

With right sides facing join the ends using a mattress stitch, ensuring that panels from both sides match.
